NCTGF News Maturity Rating Scale Extended



Assessment outcomes to the National Clinical Trials Governance Framework (NCTGF) occurring before 31 December 2029 will not impact the HSOs assessment outcome under the second edition of the NSQHS Standards.

Northern Health was assessed to the NCTGF actions using the maturity rating scale, for the first accreditation cycle in May 2024. All subsequent accreditation cycles conducted before 31 December 2029 will also be assessed under the maturity rating scale.
